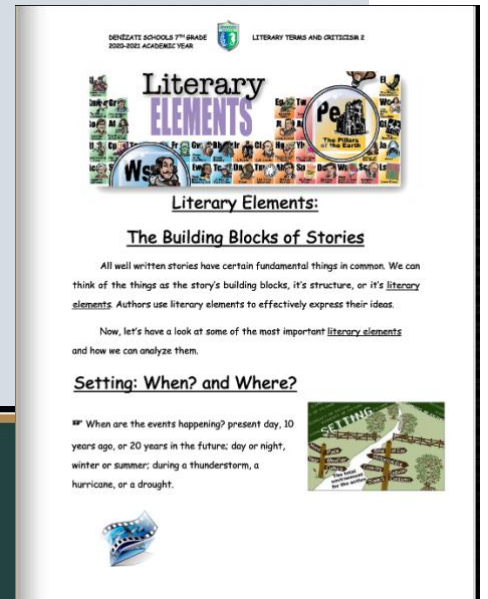
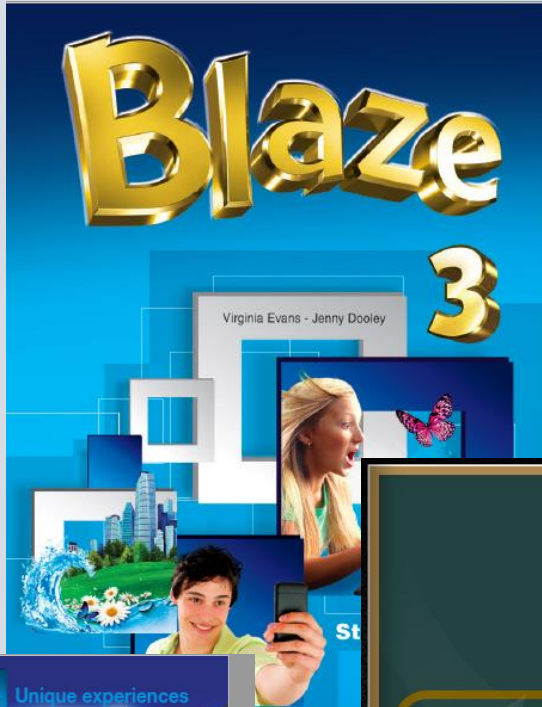


## 7. SINIF İNGİLİZCE DERS ETKİNLİKLERİ

## 7th GRADE ENGLISH CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES

At Denizati Schools students have 8 class hours of English a week; 5 class hours for Main course and 3 class hours for Skills. Lessons are conducted by two separate teachers parallelly in each class. Our lesson activities are enriched by digital and visual components to make online lessons more eye-catching for students.



## Main Course:

Haftada 5 saat Blaze 3 SB ve WB kitapları ile işlenmektedir. Dersler bu kitabın dinleme, video, quiz , oyun ve diğer bir çok interaktif içeriklerden oluşan digital versiyonu ile işlenmektedir. Her konu işlendikten sonra o konu ile ilgili etkinlikler Workbook'tan işlenerek konularının pekiştirilmesi hedeflenmektedir.

Main Course classes are instructed by the software version of Blaze 3 SB and WB, a course book for learners of English at CEFR Level B1. The software of the course book has various interactive digital components such as interactive games, quizzes, audios and videos parallel with each modules. Students are also assigned by reinforcement activities from Workbook to enhance the subjects they have already learned.

The "Teen troubles (1.3)" section includes a spidergram exercise where students complete a diagram with words related to teen problems. The words provided are: loneliness, exam, family, lack, exercise, peer, sleeping, bullying. The spidergram is structured as follows:

- Home**: loneliness, sleeping habits, family problems
- Teen problems**: (central node)
- School**: exam stress, peer pressure, bullying
- Health**: lack of sleep, lack of exercise

## Skills:

Haftada 3 saat Skills dersleri öğretmenlerimiz tarafından hazırlanan defter kitabın zenginleştirilmiş digital versiyonundan işlenmektedir. Defter kitapta İngiliz Edebiyatının klasikleşmiş öykülerinden öğrencilerimizin yaş ve İngilizce düzeyleri gözetilerek seçilen 12 hikayenin edebi terimler açısından analizi yapılmaktadır. Bu kitapta yine öğrencilerimizin eleştirel bakış açısını geliştirmeye yönelik etkinlikler bulunmaktadır. Ayrıca bu hikayeler eklenen ses ve video dosyaları ile dinleme ve izleme özelliği ile uzaktan eğitim sürecinde öğrencilerin ilgisini çekerek öğrenmelerini desteklemektedir.

Our English Skill classes are enriched by two books; one is the English Notebook (Literary Terms and Criticism 2) and the other one is Discovery fiction Introduction. The English Notebook, which consists of 12 classical short stories from famous writers, are prepared by English Department to enhance students' reading skills, language learning, and enjoyment of literature.

### CHAPTER 4

#### THE STORY OF AN INVITATION (by Lucy Maud Montgomery)

##### A. THE AUTHOR



Lucy Maud Montgomery OBE (November 30, 1874 - April 24, 1942), published as L. M. Montgomery, was a Canadian author best known for a series of novels beginning in 1908 with *Anne of Green Gables*. The book was an immediate success. *Anne Shirley*, an orphaned girl, made Montgomery famous in her lifetime and gave her an international following.<sup>[1]</sup>

The first novel was followed by a series of sequels with Anne as the central character. Montgomery went on to publish 20 novels as well as 530 short stories, 500 poems, and 30 essays. Most of the novels were set in *Prince Edward Island*, and locations within Canada's smallest province became a literary landmark and popular tourist site - namely *Green Gables* farm, the genesis of *Prince Edward Island National Park*. She was made an officer of the *Order of the British Empire* in 1935.

Montgomery's work, diaries and letters have been read and studied by school and readers worldwide.

##### B. STORY

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Skills derslerinde işleyeceğimiz bir diğer kitap ise Kuzey Amerikalı yazarların hikayelerinden oluşan Discovery Fiction Introduction kitabıdır. Bu kitapta bulunan hikayeler de edebi terimler açısından incelenecektir. Bu kitapta yine eleştirel düşünce ve metin incelemeye yönelik etkinlikler bulunmaktadır.

Lessons are conducted by digital flipbook version of the book English notebook supplemented with audios and videos of the stories. Similarly, Discovery Fiction is an anthology of short stories by American writers. Thought-provoking discussing and writing assignments encourage students to interpret and appreciate literature.
